
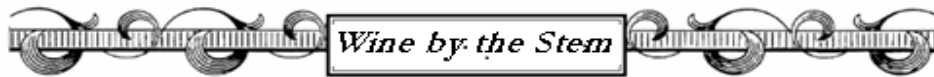

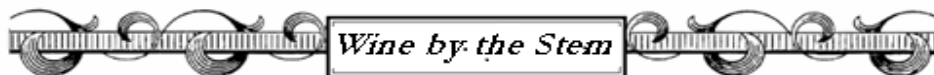

Port is classified as a fortified wine, meaning that a clear grape spirit (usually aguardente, a type of brandy) is added during fermentation. This stops the fermentation process and preserves most of the grapes' natural sugars, giving Port its signature sweet flavor profile. Then, the Port is put into large oak casks for approximately 18 months, after which it is assessed as to a specific style of Port wine.

Madeira's unique taste comes from repeatedly heating the wine. The heating creates a wine with fascinating flavors of roasted nuts, stewed fruit, caramel, and toffee.

The sauvignon blanc grape is produced in a variety of styles ranging from the dry, crisp, and racy- to the juicy, rich (with the addition of Semillon). Most of these selections see no oak in the winemaking process. Some fruits that shine through are lemon, apple, grapefruit, and kiwi.

Capture winemaker notes: The Tradition Sauvignon Blanc elevates the purity of the variety through stainless steel fermentation and ten months of sur lie aging. The result is an expression of bright citrus such as lime peel, white stonefruit, and green apple fragrances. Our vineyards highlight the ideal characteristics of Sauvignon Blanc with mineral texture, brilliant acidity, and a fresh finish.

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

Wines produced from the sangiovese grape tend to be medium in body and fresh with higher acids to balance the fruit. The acidity in the wine make it lively and super food friendly especially to cut through with the rich sauces.

The original "Super Tuscan" wine was Sassicaia. In 1970, the Marchesi Incisa della Rocchetta went against tradition and added cabernet sauvignon to sangiovese. This was illegal at the time as the Italian government strictly regulated all wine production. Because this wine didn't fit into their strict laws, it was deemed a vino di tavola, or Table Wine. Decades later, these "Super Tuscan" wines are among the most prized in Italy.

Typically lighter than Cabernet Sauvignon, flavors of red fruit, Asian Spice and dried herbs, Cabernet Franc is usually medium in body, with high acidity.


